Most useful internally – its how we explain to each other what we are trying to achieve Supports generation of other external facing documentation: proposals, business cases, etc Used to provide structure to the delivery plan




A prioritised list of the things that we want to do with clear alignment with the strategic aims and objectives – could also be called a detailed roadmap






Five pre-populated sections – you can add individual notes or notes as a group in each of the sections by clicking on the corresponding + sign





Five pre-populated sections – you can add individual notes or notes as a group in each of the sections by clicking on the corresponding + sign






Comments will populate the space below the section in near-real-time. If you see a comment you like you can indicate this by clicking on the heart icon.

You should be able to see comments from all the groups as they publish them.





If you have a comment to make that doesn't fit into the section headings just add it to the first column



Form into breakout groups of 5 to 6 people

Discuss the different section headings within the theme You don't have to discuss them all – just those the group is interested in

Nominate one member of the group to enter comments into the padlet They may also be asked to comment on behalf of the group during the discussion sessions
