Behaviour

You will be expected to behave responsibly at all times and respect the rights of University staff and other students. During the event, staff may explain some additional rules and regulations that will apply. It is expected that you will adhere to them for your own health and safety, and that of other students and staff. In the event of serious incidents of misbehaviour, such as (but not limited to) bullying, the use of sexually inappropriate/racist/homophobic/sexist language, or encouraging the use of illegal substances, you will be removed from the session and not allowed to join again.

Online Usage Agreement
